

## NEW PERSI BOARD MEMBER

The Public Employee Retirement System of Idaho (PERSI) is pleased to announce Joy Fisher has been appointed to the Retirement Board as a new Trustee. Ms. Fisher is the Director of Foundation and Investment Accounting for the Trust and Investment Office at the University of Idaho, where she's worked since 1982. Ms. Fisher has a Bachelor's degree in Accounting and Finance from the University of Idaho, and an MBA from Washington State University.



She is a Certified Public Accountant in the State of Idaho. Ms. Fisher currently serves on the Boards of Directors for the Friends of Idaho Public Television, University of Idaho Arboretum Associates, and the Idaho Youth Ranch Foundation. She has also served major roles on numerous University committees including the Retiree Benefits Task Force, Administrative Computing Committee, Chart of Accounts Committee, and the Leadership and Training Task Force.

Ms. Fisher replaced Clifford T. Hayes, former Post Falls Police Chief, who recently retired. PERSI is grateful to Chief Hayes for his many years of service to PERSI.

PERSI is directed by a five-member Retirement Board. Board members are appointed by the Governor of the State of Idaho for terms lasting 5 years. These appointments are subject to Senate confirmation. State law requires that two members of the Board be active PERSI members with at least 10 years of service and three members be Idaho citizens who are not members of the system except by reason of having served on the board.
