



## MyPERSI's PIN System

MyPERSI allows PERSI members to access their PERSI information online when it is convenient for them. Before using myPERSI for the first time, members must register using a personal identification number (PIN) that is assigned by PERSI and mailed to the address on file. If you are a member and not yet registered, you must request your PIN before registering for myPERSI.

Request your PIN by clicking on the "myPERSI login" link in the upper right area of PERSI's homepage, then click "Register". When the registration page appears, click on "Request New PIN" to have your PIN mailed to you. Once you receive the PIN, you can go back to myPERSI and set up your login name and password, which you will use to login thereafter. Keep your PIN in a safe place, though, because it will be needed to verify your identity when making changes to your address or other information.
